

## No. 7, Horchien at Banda Hilir, Melaka.

*No. 7, Fried Horchien or fried oysters*, has her humble beginnings at the No.7 Stall at “*Gluttons Corner*” at Banda Hilir during the 1970’s and 1980’s era. Situated just in front of the Melaka Straits before the sea was reclaimed in late 1980’s (which now stands Mahkota Parade), *No. 7 Horchien* was a favourite with Malaccans and tourists alike. In fact, their fried oysters are still as good as ever. Not too starchy or “eggy” and the oysters are just right – not too small or too big.
